

## Quarters Size and Minimum Bedroom Requirements

DoD Instruction 4165.63M provides the minimum bedroom requirements for assigning FH. The table below summarizes these requirements:

Number of Dependents (Excluding Spouse)	Bedrooms
None	1
Two, except as follows:	2
One 10 years or older	3
One 6 years or older; other two of the opposite sex with one 6 years or older	3
Three, except as follows:	3
Two of the three are 10 years or older	3
One 10 years or older; other two of the opposite sex with one 6 years or older	4
Four, except as follows:	3
One 10 years or older	4
One 6 years or older; other three opposite sex with one 6 years or older	4
Two 6 years or older, of opposite sex, and other two same sex	4
Two 10 years or older, other two opposite sex, with one 6 years or older	4
Five, except as follows:	4
Two or more 10 years or older	5
One 10 years or older, one 6 years or older and opposite sex of the other three	5
<p>Notes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Assign one bedroom to member or member with spouse. Dependent family members married to each other (dependent parents of member or member's spouse) are entitled to one bedroom.</li> <li>2. If inventory permits, assign one child per bedroom.</li> <li>3. No child may share a bedroom with parents.</li> <li>4. No more than two children may share a bedroom, except with the CO, MCAS Iwakuni approval.</li> <li>5. A child 6 years or older may not share a bedroom with a child of the opposite sex.</li> <li>6. Children over 10 years old may not share a bedroom.</li> <li>7. Dependents attending high school and college full-time away from member's duty station are counted as dependents for bedroom requirements only if listed on PCS orders.</li> </ol>	

MCO 11000.22, Marine Corps Bachelor and Family Housing Management stipulates the following:

- (1) Senior officers (O-6) are entitled to four bedrooms.
- (2) Field grade officers (O4-O5, W4-W5), and senior NCO (E6-E9) are entitled to three bedrooms minimum.
- (3) Company grade officers (O1-O3, W1-W3), and junior NCOs' (E5 and below) bedroom requirements will be determined using reference (a).

Unaccompanied senior and field grade officers may apply for on-base FH if in a senior leadership billet. Their applications will be reviewed by the FH office on a case by case basis. These are exceptions to policy and must be endorsed favorably by the CO, MCAS Iwakuni, with final determinations made by MCICOM.
