

UNACCOMPANIED CHECKLIST



UPON NOTIFICATION OF ORDERS TO IWAKUNI

Begin and complete the checkout process at the command you are detaching from.

Contact your gaining command in Iwakuni and inform them that you have orders to Iwakuni.

- *Do not be afraid to contact your gaining command. They want to help you stay informed as you PCS to Iwakuni.*
- *Utilize the [phone directory](#) at the PCS home page to access the number of your gaining command.*

Ensure you have a passport.

- *Contact your local passport agent for guidance.*
- *It is also recommended you obtain a drivers' license before PCS'ing as well.*

Make travel arrangements at the Passenger Travel Office.

- *Everyone PCS'ing to Iwakuni for the foreseeable future should do so on the Patriot Express.*
- *Upon confirmation of your itinerary on the Patriot Express, [contact your gaining command](#).*

Provide your gaining command with a copy of your orders and your travel itinerary.

Arrange a household goods shipment at your installation's Distribution Management Office (DMO).

Maintain constant contact with your unit.

- *Your unit will be able to set your barracks or bachelor officer quarters room up comfortably before your arrival.*
- *Establish best form of electronic payment so that you can reimburse anyone from your unit who incurs any costs on your behalf (Zelle, Venmo, NavyFed, Cash App, etc).*

Review [amenities available at the barracks/BOQ ROM locations](#) for situational awareness.

24-72 HOURS BEFORE DEPARTING ON YOUR FLIGHT TO IWAKUNI



Travel with an adequate amount of cash for any emergency situations. Estimate approximately 20,000 yen.

In your carry-on luggage, ensure you pack the essentials you will want as soon as you arrive and conduct 14 days of ROM, such as linens and entertainment.

It is recommended that you arrive in Iwakuni with your cell phone already unlocked and with a 3-4 week international data plan with your cell carrier so that you will have cell service once you arrive and throughout your time in ROM.

UPON ARRIVAL ABOARD MCAS IWAKUNI

Upon landing at MCAS Iwakuni, you will be greeted at the AMC terminal by a sponsor coordinator and will undergo a brief medical screening. From there you will be taken via unit transportation to your barracks or BOQ building. Once you go inside, you will be required to conduct restriction of movement and remain at your residence for 14 days.

Your unit can leave things in your barracks or BOQ room before you arrive.

THROUGHOUT YOUR 14 DAYS IN ROM

Rely on your unit for any additional needs and have them deliver to you.

- *Have them drop off items at your front door and you retrieve them when they leave.*

Chow will be delivered to your door 3 times a day, or as coordinated with your sponsor if you elect to have them purchase groceries.

Communicate to your unit or sponsor when you have [laundry or need trash disposed of](#).

Do not leave your residence under any circumstance, unless you have a medical emergency. If you have a medical emergency, call the Branch Health clinic at 0827-94-8100.

Do not host anyone within your residence.

You will be able to sign up for Boingo WiFi in your barracks or BOQ room.

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AFTER ROM ENDS



Go with sponsor to your unit check-in point after ROM is complete.

Attend the Welcome Aboard brief the first Monday after ROM ends.

Familiarize yourself with the base.
